





Plan of N.E. 1/4 Township 20, Range 24, West of the Sixth Meridian







Reference your file 24666 concerning highway encroachment on C.P.R. Right-of-Way near Ashcroft.

Your letter of September 26th is acknowledged along with the plans provided for the Encroachment Agreement. Discussion with your Mr. Williams on the ground indicate that the encroachments will not be as set out in your plans but will be reduced at certain points along the way. At the time I contacted Mr. Williams on the ground he was instructed to relocate the fence which the Highways Department had constructed to a point at least twenty feet clear of the center line of the C. P. Rail track in order to permit operation of track spreader at this point. It is the intent that our operations not be impeded in any way by the work being done.

The following was as per telex to the Department of Highways of April 18th addressed to Mr. Dennison in Victoria and will form part of the Encroachment Agreement.

"Department of Highways will provide a minimum of 11 feet supported track grade (11 feet from center line of track at an elevation of 2 feet below base of rail) at the present time and 13 feet supported track grade (13 feet from center line of track at an elevation of 2 feet below base of rail) at such time as company requires same in areas where company right-of-way is bounded by the Thompson River, where back slope of road reduces support to 11 feet, and where back slopes of road fall within registered company right-of-way.

Areas capable of support to said dimensions within the limit of company right-of-way based on the normal one and one-half to one fill slope on fully supported right-ofway do not form part of this Agreement." The as constructed crosssections on the road will be requested to form part of the Encroachment Agreement. These cross sections of the final results of the work will have to be accepted by the Railway Company prior to inclusion in the Agreement. It was noted, although not drawn to the attention of the Project Supervisor at the time, that in certain extremely critical areas the toe of slope had been again worked on by the blade of a grater. It is assumed that these places will be repaired and that the Department of Highways will not cause to be removed from the toe of the slope, additional material which has been placed or which will be placed on the existing slopes to provide for the support as stated above as required.

Now that the Highways have formally constructed as a Government Project the road in this area, it is presumed that the indenture made the third day of June 1886 with J. C. Barnes of Ashcroft before M. W. Tuirwhitt-Drake and Queen Victoria as represented by the Minister of Railways and Canals of the Dominion of Canada becomes void. However, it is considered that the Railway for the distances involved from Ashcroft through to Barnes Creek is to have the support provided as stated above outside of the particular areas mentioned. Beyond that the Agreement and the need for support comes to an end.

Will you please on completion of the work, provide to this office the final cross sections and the Encroachment plans of the work in its' completed stage. At that time the Encroachment Agreement will be drawn up.



Reference letter of August 14th, file GBØK-459-871-73, concerning roadway encroachments along the right-of-way, north of Ashcroft for the Department of Highways to serve the new Dupont plant.

It is drawn to your attention that in all of the encroachment areas, an Encroachment Agreement is to be set up to protect the Company at the expense of the Department of Highways in the support of the railway embankment.

A telex of April 18th, 1973, sent to Mr. G. Lindsay of Gepac, with a copy to the Chief Engineer, Department of Highways, Victoria, as attached, outlines requirements for the Railway with respect to the support of the bank. These areas are as coloured in red on the Department of Highway's plan submitted. It was agreed on the ground that the Company at the present time should be provided with support at a point 11 ft. from the centre of the track, 2 ft. below the existing base of rail. Where this is not the case, the Railway Company will be depositing additional material on the slope to provide for this support and the Highways Department will not remove material from the bottom of the slope. As you will note, the Company has required that ultimately the support provided should be 13 ft. from centre line of track at 2 ft. below the existing base of rail. The intent of the latter was to provide a reasonable amount of leeway in the protection of the embankment.

The location of the Telecommunications pole line on the right-of-way in the areas involved, through the Encroachment Agreement are to be protected as are CP Rail facilities. The protection of the Railway in the manner so stated, and also the CP Telecommunications poles must be included in the Encroachment Agreement. Our Regional Engineer is extremely interested in this, in view of the fact that we have several points on the Canyon Division where support of the Railway embankment became, for a time, a rather difficult problem. We will be further requesting the Law Department to advise how the requirements above are to be stated in the Agreement. To date, all we have is a standard Encroachment Agreement which excludes the special clauses required, as a result of attempts to obtain a special agreement in this particular case.

We will require seven sets of plans to have agreement drawn up to cover.

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
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
