Project Schedule

- The Pattullo critical path schedule includes starting the pile driving of the main in-river tower by November 2020.
- The contractor must complete the in-river work within the fish window (June 2020 to Feb 2021).
- If the contractor cannot complete the in-river work by February 2021, then the in-river work will need to be pushed back to late June 2021.

Archaeological Work: Static Pile Load Test

- At the start of the pandemic in March, Indigenous archaeological monitors were not available on site as their communities went into quarantine.
- The project worked with Indigenous groups to set-up remote monitoring of the archaeological work in order to ensure they could still participate.

 The DFO- Fisheries Act Authorization permit is on the critical path for permitting, and is required in order for in-river work to begin
