I respectfully advise that the Department will, in the near future, commence the reconstruction of the Cache Creek to Lenonade Flats section of the Trans Canada Highway. This will necessitate an encroachment within "Mauvais Rocher" Indian Reserve No. 5.

For your information and convenience, prints of part of the Location Plan are being forwarded under separate cover to illustrate the relocation of the right-of-way within said Reserve.

From a ground inspection it was observed that the new highway lies to the north and above the existing road, bearing into the sidehill to maintain grade. The 3.23 acres of land involved consists of unimproved and non-agricultural land. It is felt that an offer of \$25.00 per acre is ample for this type of rocky, sagebrush range land.

During my recent stay in Kamloops, I took the opportunity to meet Mr. Clark, the Indian Supervisor, and left a print of the plan for his files.




