



There are quite a few residents that very concerned about some trees marked for removal at the Morning Beach, beach access.

Here is what I know so far:


It appears that MOTI is considering the removal of five large, mature trees at the end of the Morning Beach shore access. That area is not CRD or BC Parks land, it belongs to Moti (Srow). That area is in SHORELINE AND MARINE DEVELOPMENT PERMIT AREA (2) (I understand that means nothing, if the trees are deemed danger trees)


However, the five trees are very close to the shore access boundary with the adjoining property - 754 Ellis Road. The neighbour has, in the past, requested removal of three of the trees as posing a danger to the residence, which was constructed under the "danger" trees more than 15 years ago The neighbours have, in the past flagged the trees.

MOTI has apparently assessed the trees and is now seeking quotes for the tree removals. Our local road maintenance contractor (Emcon Services Inc- Shay Morgan) is not involved in the process. We initially noticed the tree tagging on Saturday, but it appears they have been marked for a couple of weeks.

Two of the trees are large (7-8 foot diameter) firs, that appear to be heathy trees, but well-branched, and are furthest away from the house. There is a tall cedar, showing signs of stress and top die back closer to the house. The other two trees are balsam/firs that have split tops, but otherwise look healthy.

I understand that Moti does not have to consult with our Parks and Rec board, but this is, after all, is a public park, shore access and one that is heavily used by residents and visitors. These larger trees are a few of handful larger trees in that area. The root systems certainly run through bank.
