Good afternoon everyone:

For May 2023, the most active campaign was regarding old growth forests. There is a new sub-campaign that has gained traction; specifically calling for support of MP Patrick Weiler's recent motion titled "M-83 Old Growth Forest Protection". Additional details on the motion can be found [here](#) . The remainder of Old Growth campaign correspondence remained the same as previous months: support for logging deferrals, requests for an increase of IPCAs, and general support for old growth protection.

This month there has been a significant increase in correspondence regarding spotted owls. The campaign was split into two separate batches: a COUNT for the campaign letters (183), and an FYI batch for all the personalized and unique FYI emails (95). Please note that many of the incoming FYI correspondence referred to this Global News article .

In May there has been a marked decline in the number of incoming Wolf Cull correspondence from April but is still one of the most active campaigns we receive.

Hello everyone:

For April 2023 the most active campaign was regarding old growth forests; following along the same theme as previous months: support for logging deferrals, requests for an increase of IPCAs, and general support for old growth protection.

The month of April saw a new campaign regarding logging within the Kwakiutl Nation. Highlights include concerns regarding recent cutblocks in the Suquash Creek area, a lack of consolation with the First Nations community, and emphasizing the cultural significance of the remaining old-growth in the territory. The wolf cull campaign has continued to have a high number of incoming letters, with an increase in versions that reference the recently released photos and videos.

		<p>Too much spotted owl forest habitat in BC's Lower Mainland has already been logged. This has led to the near-extinction of the species in Canada, with only one wild-born spotted owl and two captive-raised owls remaining on the landscape in the Fraser Canyon region.</p> <p>For spotted owls to survive and recover to healthy numbers again, BC must cancel all logging permits in spotted owl critical habitat and must cease issuing new logging permits to cut the remaining habitat. The BC government in partnership with First Nations must take action to preserve every hectare of remaining spotted owl old-growth forest habitat.</p> <p>Older second-growth forests must also be protected to enable new old-growth spotted owl habitat to grow.</p> <p>For too long logging interests have driven land management decisions in B.C. With 1,900 species at risk in BC due to habitat loss, the provincial government must do everything it can to stop the loss of old-growth forest habitat immediately and permanently.</p> <p>It is in the public interest to halt the extinction of spotted owls by protecting and expanding their old-growth forest habitat. The elimination of this habitat will lead to a domino of extinctions, starting with the owl and ending with who knows how many others.</p>
