Good afternoon everyone:

For May 2023, the most active campaign was regarding old growth forests. There is a new sub-campaign that has gained traction; specifically calling for support of MP Patrick Weiler's recent motion titled "M-83 Old Growth Forest Protection". Additional details on the motion can be found here. The remainder of Old Growth campaign correspondence remained the same as previous months: support for logging deferrals, requests for an increase of IPCAs, and general support for old growth protection.

This month there has been a significant increase in correspondence regarding spotted owls. The campaign was split into two separate batches: a COUNT for the campaign letters (183), and an FYI batch for all the personalized and unique FYI emails (95). Please note that many of the incoming FYI correspondence referred to this Global News article.

In May there has been a marked decline in the number of incoming Wolf Cull correspondence from April but is still one of the most active campaigns we receive.
